We look forward to seeing the kids in Nov/Dec and wish to take clothing and continued food support. What better Christmas gifts for these needy children.



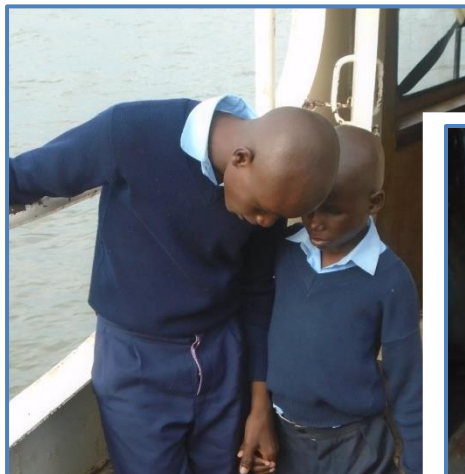

Going back to Kenya to visit the children

The Kenyan Presidential election is scheduled in August, and we pray for peace. We will wait until late November to return to Kenya, staying with the children for about 3 weeks in early December.

Safe Haven has its longest program during the late October – early January school break, when children are most vulnerable. Many families do not have money to provide for their kids; there is little food and no jobs are available. Children are often orphaned early and/or born HIV positive. At Safe Haven, kids have food, medical care as needed, and educational activities.
