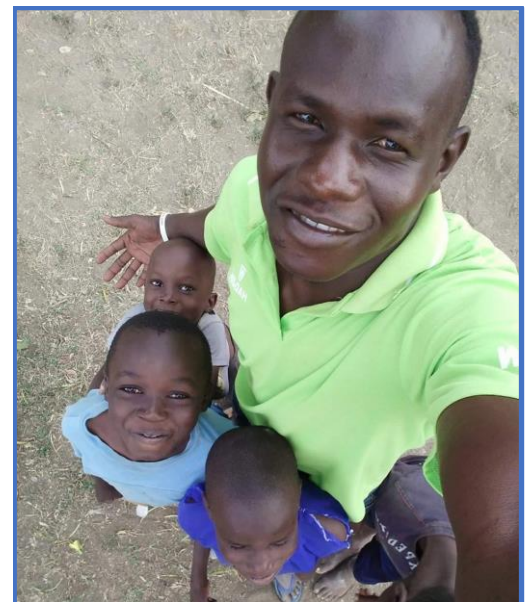
August School Break Program
